

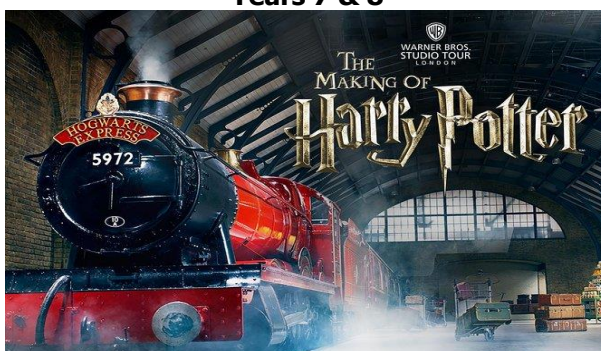

This trip will be a wonderful cultural experience for our students and in spite of a rise in costs, we have worked hard to obtain the best value for the trip and this has been finalised at £250 per student.

What is included in the price?

- **Coach travel for two days**
- **The making of Harry Potter (Warner Bros. Studio Tour)**
- **Accommodation at Wembley International Hotel**
- **Evening meal**
- **Breakfast (day 2)**
- **Packed lunch (day 2)**
- **A guided tour around Oxford's main sites learning about the history of the colleges and university**

On the first day the students will either need to bring a packed lunch or money to purchase lunch. You will be able to make the deposit payment via ParentPay. Following this the outstanding balance will need to be paid by **Friday 14th June 2024**.
